DEFINE: ORCHESTRA OR BAND INSTRUMENTS

Orchestras and Bands represent the body of Christ, blending together in harmony to communicate the Word of the Lord. Each instrument is a parable as to their function within the overall group.

1) Higher pitched instruments carry the melody or message, move at a faster rate, have higher sounds and voices that are raised up above the overall orchestra sound. These are like the flutes, clarinets, violins, oboes, trumpets. They might represent the teachers and pastors who cover a lot of ground fast, when communicating His message.

2) The lower pitched instruments are foundational sounds that carry the foundational notes of chords and keys, and they move at much slower rates, keeping the foundational sounds long and drawn out so as to provide a platform for the faster moving instrumental sounds to spring forth. These lower pitched instruments are the trombones, cellos, bases, tubas, bassoons and french horns. They might represent the apostles and prophets who declare times and seasons and not necessarily past paced moments within the season.

3. The rhythm and percussion instruments provide the overall pace for all movement. These are the drums and

various rhythm sounds. They give alignment and synch in which to blend all movement. These might represent the evangelists whose feet (pace) are blessed with good news.

A roof is a parable of dwelling under the Lord's protection.

SYNONYMS: Carport, tarp, canopy, covered deck, tent.

PARKED CAR

Parked cars represent waiting upon the Lord before moving out in a decision. Wait for answers, His guidance, counsel, help, deliverance.

SYNONYMS: Garage, parking lot, driveway, carport, stop sign, curbside, parking meter.

Ps 37:34

Wait on the LORD, And keep His way, And He shall exalt you to inherit the land;
When the wicked are cut off, you shall see it.

QUILT

A quilt is usually patch worked material sown together to cover and warm in a night season. To sew material together is putting pieces of God's Word together and joining them to make a warm blanket for a cold season.

A blanket is also a symbol of covering and/or hiding.

SYNONYMS: Puzzles, to join, connect, draw together, build, gather.

Ex 36:37

He also made a screen for the tabernacle door, of blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine woven linen, made by a weaver.

CASSETTE TAPES

Old tapes are old thought life that is playing re-runs. Get rid of the old tapes and move forward into the mind of Christ.

SYNONYMS: Going in circles, wandering, wavering, looking backwards, no hope, no growth, not advancing.

2 Cor 10:5

Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

ANTLERS

The horns of an animal represent the Lord's power, trumpets, announcements from the watchmen.

Ps 132:17

There I will make the horn {7161} of David grow; I will prepare a lamp for My Anointed .

OT:7161

OT:7161 qeren (keh'-ren); from OT:7160; a horn (as projecting); by implication, a flask, cornet; by resembl. an elephant's tooth (i.e. ivory), a corner (of the altar), a peak (of a mountain), a ray (of light); figuratively, power:

KJV - hill, horn.

COWBOY

A cowboy lassoes the wild independent ones, wrestles with flesh, and marks them for the Lord and finally trains them to obey. These are discipline angels sent on assignment to hunt, fish and gather and train.

SYNONYMS: Angels of discipline.

Jer 16:16-18

"Behold, I will send for many fishermen," says the LORD, "and they shall fish them; and afterward I will send for many hunters, and they shall hunt them from every mountain and every hill, and out of the holes of the rocks. 17 For My eyes are on all their ways; they are not hidden from My face, nor is their iniquity hidden from My eyes.

ROSETTA STONE

This stone is a parable of being the gift or key to interpret parables, dark speech, signs, visions, dreams and riddles.

SYNONYMS: Dictionary, glossary, solve, understand, enigmas made clear, clues.

Gen 40:8

So Joseph said to them, "Do not interpretations belong to God? Tell them to me, please."

PURSE

A purse is a symbol of provision of the Lord. To be equipped and prepared.

Ex 4:2

So the LORD said to him, "What is that in your hand ?"

Luke 22:36 KJV

Then said he unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take *it*, and likewise *his* scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.

SILVER PLATTER

Silver represents redemption, to be purchased or bought with a price.

SYNONYMS: Silver coins, silver jewelry, silver cloud lining.

Num 18:16

And those redeemed of the devoted things you shall redeem when one month old, according to your valuation, for five shekels of silver.

Gen 37:28

Sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver .

Matt 26:15

What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?" And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver.

HORSE HALTER

A horse halter are divine restraints placed upon one's flesh, in particular one's mouth. It also represents stubbornness to obey.

SYNONYMS: Braces.

Ps 32:9

Do not be like the horse or like the mule, Which have no understanding, Which must be harnessed with bit and bridle, Else they will not come near you.

DONKEY

A donkey represents a calling that carries burdens, and is a lowly servant.

SYNONYMS: Elephant, oxen.

Matt 21:5

'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey .'"

MOWED LAWN

Fresh mowed lawn represents maintaining one's life in balance, order and self discipline. Being willing to be regularly pruned of the Lord.

SYNONYMS: Lawn mower, cut grass, harvest, maintenance, prosperous and fruitful.

John 15:2-3

Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

PLOWED FIELD

A plowed field represents a life that has had its stumbling stones removed, weeds uprooted and whose heart is soft and yielded to receive the Word of the Lord.

SYNONYMS: Prepared after sifted, turned over, sins uprooted, and all that offends removed.

Matt 13:23

But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty."

GUM

Chewing the Word of the Lord but not swallowing it. Meditation of what is not understood.

Ps 119:148

My eyes are awake through the night watches, That I may meditate on Your word.

HAIR SCRUNCHIE

These are cloth covered rubber bands that hold women's hair back. They are spiritual symbols of wrinkles in one's covering or glory. The glory of the Lord being held back until the wrinkles are gone.

1 Cor 11:15-16

But if a woman has long hair, it is a glory to her; for her hair is given to her for a covering.

MILK

To enjoy the pure and simple Word of the Lord. To grow up from a baby Christian.

SYNONYMS: Cream, icecream, milk cow, baby bottle, breast feed, yogurt.

Heb 5:12-14

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.

COFFEE

A wakeup call to no longer spiritually slumber as those in the world slumber. Wake up and understand the spiritual world around you and how it relates to your personal life.

SYNONYMS: Latte, Caffeine, Tea, Java

Rom 13:11-13

And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. 12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

Eph 5:13-14

But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light. 14 Therefore He says: "Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light.

LION

The lion of Judah is Jesus Christ. The devouring lion is the enemy. The lion calling represents a kingly authority.

Rev 5:5

Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals."

1 Peter 5:8-10

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9 Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

Gen 49:9-10

Judah is a lion's whelp; From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He bows down, he lies down as a lion; And as a lion, who shall rouse him? 10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

CAT

Cats are probably most known for their tongues, which purr when content and lick themselves to keep clean. They can represent speaking in tongues.

Their personalities can also represent a life of independence and other cat traits. Observe the nature of your cat and then compare to yourself.

But no man can tame the tongue . It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. 9 With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so. Does a spring send forth fresh water and bitter from the same opening?

DOG

Dogs can represent people traits of loyalty, obedience, affection, faithful. They can also represent loud barking or intimidation, and other negative traits. Observe the nature of your dog and then compare to yourself.

Matt 15:27

And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table."

MONKEY

The monkey can be a parable of a monkey scratching his head and not having a clue as to what is going on or understanding. If so, this represents one's identity or calling in God that is not yet manifest.

Prov 8:5

O you simple ones, understand prudence, And you fools, be of an understanding heart.

COW

A cow represents giving mother's milk to God's kids. Cows are usually gentle in nature. They can be trusted to be habitual and punctual.

Isa 7:21-22

It shall be in that day that a man will keep alive a young cow and two sheep; 22 So it shall be, from the abundance of milk they give, That he will eat curds; For curds and honey everyone will eat who is left in the land.

HOT SAUCE

Hot sauce or Mexican food represent the red hot passion of the Lord.

SYNONYMS: Zeal, passion, hot, flame, zest for God's Word. Fire in bones, enchilada sauce, taco sauce, chili peppers

Isa 9:7

Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

WHALE

The biggest fish among the nations. The apostolic calling.

Acts 2:43-44

Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles .

GRAPE VINES

I heard it through the grape vine! A symbol of God's connected people, who are clinging to the Vine of Jesus Christ. Their fruit is the wine and gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:15-18

For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. 16 But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: 17'And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. 18 And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days;

APPLE

The cliché, “An apple a day keeps the doctor away” is a parable for healing.

Song 8:5

Who is this coming up from the wilderness, Leaning upon her beloved? I awakened you under the apple tree. There your mother brought you forth; There she who bore you brought you forth.

SPATULA

A parable of turning over, being flipped, being sifted, something being overturned. Turned upside down or right side up.

SYNONYMS: Sift, repent, align, pervert, in right standing.

Acts 3:19

Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,

BEAR

White bear: The fear of the Lord. Black bear: Fear of man. The fierce and nurturing of God.

Rom 11:22

Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness.

HAT

To cover the head for protection against principalities.

SYNONYMS: Bonnet, helmet, scarf, umbrella, cap, wig.

1 Cor 11:10

For this reason the woman ought to have a symbol of authority on her head, because of the angels .

CAMEL

Camels live in desert places, which are a symbol of isolation and loneliness. They are able to be sustained for long periods of time on past water.

Can be a symbol of the difficulty rich people have in entering the Kingdom of God.

Matthew 19:24 KJV

And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.

Gen 24:62-64

And Isaac went out to meditate in the field in the evening; and he lifted his eyes and looked, and there, the camels were coming. 64 Then Rebekah lifted her eyes, and when she saw Isaac she dismounted from her camel ;

RED X

The target or spot that is a goal or destiny. To be marked by the Lord to be set apart.

SYNONYMS: Bull's eye. Arrow. Letter X. A plus + sign. Check mark.

Ps 37:37 37 Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; For the future of that man is peace.

Ezek 9:4-6 "Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and put a mark on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within it." 5 To the others He said in my hearing, "Go after him through the city and kill; do not let your eye spare, nor have any pity. 6 Utterly slay old and young men, maidens and little children and women; but do not come near anyone on whom is the mark ; and begin at My sanctuary."

RED LIGHT

A symbol of warning.

SYNONYMS: Caution, stop. Warning light. Danger.

Heb 11:7

By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household,

GRAPES

The fruit of being connected to the Vine of Jesus Christ. New wine of the Holy Spirit. The blood of Jesus. The communion cup in remembrance of Jesus.

John 15:5-6

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

KNIFE

Can represent the cutting edge of the Word of God. It can also represent gluttony or appetite.

SYNONYMS: Sword, blade, saw, sharp.

Heb 4:12-13 12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Prov 23:2-3 2 And put a knife to your throat If you are a man given to appetite. 3 Do not desire his delicacies, For they are deceptive food.

PEARLS

The pearl can signify a great sacrificial cost, as in the pearl of great price. Created by circling years of friction, thorns in flesh, irritants and all laid down as sacrifices to the will of King Jesus.

Matt 13:45-46

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, 46 who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

JUNGLE

Cant see the forest through the trees. A jungle or mazed environment of so many details and pressing events that one has little vision beyond the immediate obstacle.

SYNONYM: Heavy forest, little overhead light, clustered and pressed into tight place.

2 Cor 1:8

For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:

WHEEL BARROW

Learning to trust, being carried and moved by the Lord. Resting in God no matter how small the tightrope.

SYNONYMS: Wagon, dolly, vehicles, trailer, bearing burdens on wheels.

Isa 46:4

Even to your old age, I am He, And even to gray hairs I will carry you! I have made, and I will bear; Even I will carry, and will deliver you.

NIGHT DEPOSIT

Putting an investment, deposit into a safe place for keeping. Hearing the Lord at night as He deposits His wealth inside of

us. These Words are rich with destiny and longevity for our callings.

SYNONYMS: Bank, deposit, checking account, savings account, bank teller, cash, invest, stock, storage.

Job 33:14-16

For God may speak in one way, or in another, Yet man does not perceive it. 15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, When deep sleep falls upon men, While slumbering on their beds, Then He opens the ears of men, And seals their instruction.

GRAPEFRUIT

A fruit that is both bitter and sweet. Bob Jones says this is self discipline, the fruit of the Spirit which is temperance.

It can also mean swallowing the Word of God that is both bitter and sweet.

Rev 10:9

And he said to me, "Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth."

Gal 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control.

ELECTRICAL PLUG

Being plugged into the Lord's power gifts. To lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. To cast out demons. To

impart gifts through laying on of hands. To impart the Lord's Presence. To tremble at His Word.

SYNONYMS: Electricity, power lines, wiring.

Isa 66:5

Hear the word of the LORD, You who tremble at His word :

FEATHER DUSTER

To clean the area of demonic residue.

SYNONYM; Vacuum, dust, sweep, mop.

Luke 11:24-26

"When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' 25 And when he comes, he finds it swept and put in order.

WOODEN YOKE

Volunteer Captivity. To be yoked with the Lord. Soul ties. To serve when in restraints.

Matt 11:28-30

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

GLASS CLEANER

To clear one's vision or watchman's view from worldly grime. Deliverance from clouded perspective. Clear site, understanding.

SYNONYM: See glass, window, windshield. Windex, window washer.

1 Sam 3:1

And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision .

Num 24:4

The utterance of him who hears the words of God, Who sees the vision of the Almighty, Who falls down, with eyes wide open :

SALT

To preserve meat, people, nations from decay and/or devourer. The fruit of intercession. To draw the world through the gifts of God and make them thirsty for more of Him.

SYNONYMS: Saline

Matt 5:13-15 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

Mark 9:50 50 Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another."

TURQUOISE WATER

The purest and transparent water representing the fountain of life that dwells within those who love Jesus Christ. No polluted by men, the world, the demonic. Clear and free, deep and pure.

John 4:14

Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

BUTTERFLY

To have gone through the process of change and transformation by the renewing of one's mind into the mind of Christ. The journey of one's faith into Jesus' image.

SYNONYMS: Caterpillar, worm, cocoon, pupa, wings, Monarch.

Rom 12:2

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

2 Cor 3:18

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

WILLOW TREE

To bow low in humility and tears. To think little of oneself.

Isa 57:15 I dwell in the high and holy place, With him who has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

STETHOSCOPE

To listen to the condition of one's heart, soul, spirit. To know the heart of the Lord. To prepare for spiritual surgery, or listen to the results of having surgery. Circumcision of the heart.

SYNONYMS: Monitor, pace maker, doctor, surgeon

Matt 5:8

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

MOUNTAINS

Symbols of power. God's holy mountain. The enemy's hindrance.

SYNONYMS: Hill, peak, summit.

Ps 48:1

Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised In the city of our God, In His holy mountain .

Zech 4:7

Who are you, O great mountain ? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain! And he shall bring forth the capstone With shouts of "Grace, grace to it!"

Mark 11:22-24

Have faith in God. 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

FREEWAY

The holy highway of God. Walking in His righteous path, redeemed from destruction and committed to holy living.

SYNONYMS: Road, well worn path.

Isa 35:8-10

A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray. 9 No lion shall be there, Nor shall any ravenous beast go up on it; It shall not be found there. But the redeemed shall walk there, 10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

BANANAS

Bob Jones says bananas represent the fruit of the spirit of gentleness.

They are a soft hearted fruit.

Gal 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.

James 3:17-18

But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

NIGHTGOWN

The mantle or endument to rest in the Lord and resting in His calling. To have perfect belief and trust in His ability to complete that which He has started. The promise of entering into Sabbath rest.

SYNONYMS: PJs, jammies, bathrobe, sheets, pajamas, nightshirt

Heb 4:3

For we who have believed do enter that rest.

EAGLE

The calling to be a seer. One who rises up in the realm of the Spirit to have visions and see great distance with clarity. Able to rise above the serpents on earth. Also describes a prophetic generation, which is the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Deut 32:11-12

As an eagle stirs up its nest, Hovers over its young, Spreading out its wings, taking them up, Carrying them on its wings, 12 So the LORD alone led him, And there was no foreign god with him.

Rev 12:14-15

But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is

nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

TOOTHBRUSH

To wash one's mouth and words by speaking only what is good and lovely and good report.

SYNONYMS: tooth paste, mouth wash, dentist, floss, whitener

Ps 19:14

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart
Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer.

Prov 18:21 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

1 Peter 3:10 "He who would love life And see good days,
Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit.

BIKE

To expend effort to acquire faith through one's relationship with the Lord. Pushing and growing in one's faith to learn to soar. Ministry on earth, grounded and settled in moving in God.

SYNONYMS: See wheel barrow.

Isa 46:4

Even to your old age, I am He, And even to gray hairs I will carry you! I have made, and I will bear; Even I will carry, and will deliver you.

BALCONY

The cloud of witnesses view the events in your life and events on earth.

SYNONYMS: Grandstands, shelf, balcony, opera box.

Heb 12:1-2

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

IPOD

To hear the voice of the Lord and see His pictures.

SYNONYMS: See phone, cell phone.

1 Sam 3:9-10

If He calls you, that you must say, 'Speak, LORD, for Your servant hears.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place. ¹⁰ Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears."

ORNAMENT

An ornament on a tree is a description of how the Lord view us, where He places us as jewels in His crown. We are His pearls, the ones He poured great cost to purchase.

SYNONYMS: Jewels, jewelry, ornament, accessorize, decorations, glitz.

Isa 61:10-11

I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. 11 For as the earth brings forth its bud, As the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, So the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.

Zech 9:16-17

The LORD their God will save them in that day, As the flock of His people. For they shall be like the jewels of a crown, Lifted like a banner over His land — 17 For how great is its goodness And how great its beauty!

HOOK

A parable to catch a fish. God uses supernatural to draw us and bring us into His harvest.

The enemy can ensnare the flesh through enticement of the lust of flesh, eyes, and pride.

SYNONYMS: Lure, trap, entice, draw, snare, catch, bring, reel, lasso, catch.

Matt 4:20

And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. 19 Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men ." 20 They immediately left their nets and followed Him.

Matt 17:27

Jesus said to him, "Then the sons are free. 27 Nevertheless, lest we offend them, go to the sea, cast in a hook, and take the fish that comes up first. And when you have opened its mouth, you will find a piece of money; take that and give it to them for Me and you."

SCROLL

A proclamation or decree that is the Word of the Lord.

SYNONYMS: Parchment, written word, proclaim, decree, record, file, book, scribe, brief case.

Matt 13:52

Then He said to them, "Therefore every scribe instructed concerning the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out of his treasure things new and old."

UMPIRE

A parable of the pronouncements of the Lord as to the safety and validation of one returning home or making a goal.

SYNONYMS: Referee, mediator, judge, officiate, home run, foul ball, safe, protected, not qualified, walk, run.

1 Sam 22:23

Stay with me; do not fear. For he who seeks my life seeks your life, but with me you shall be safe ."

Judg 18:5-6

So they said to him, "Please inquire of God, that we may know whether the journey on which we go will be prosperous." 6 And the priest said to them, "Go in peace. The presence of the LORD be with you on your way."

STEEL GRID

The parable of a cold and hard environment in which one's perspectives are honed and forged.

SYNONYMS: toughen, harden, fortify, brace, strengthen.

Ezek 3:6-11

Surely, had I sent you to them, they would have listened to you. 7 But the house of Israel will not listen to you, because they will not listen to Me; for all the house of Israel are impudent and hard-hearted. 8 Behold, I have made your face strong against their faces, and your forehead strong against their foreheads. 9 Like adamant stone, harder than flint, I have made your forehead ; do not be afraid of them, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they are a rebellious house." 10 Moreover He said to me: "Son of man, receive into your heart all My words that I speak to you, and hear

with your ears. 11 And go, get to the captives, to the children of your people, and speak to them and tell them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD,' whether they hear, or whether they refuse."

COMPASS

The guidance of the Lord to find His direction out of a wilderness time.

SYNONYMS: Map, plan, vision, oversight, agenda, sign, trail, marked, scope, range, breadth.

Prov 29:18

8 Where there is no vision [no redemptive revelation of God], the people perish; but he who keeps the law [of God, which includes that of man] — blessed (happy, fortunate, and enviable) is he. [1 Sam 3:1; Amos 8:11,12.]

AMP

Prov 3:5-8

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. 7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. 8 It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.

TOOL BELT

Being equipped to be a builder in God's house.

SYNONYMS: Hammer, screwdriver, saw, tools of the trade in building.

Ps 127:1

Unless the LORD builds the house, They labor in vain who build it; Unless the LORD guards the city, The watchman stays awake in vain .

PEELING OF A FRUIT

To take off the old skin in order to reveal the new fruit. Removing layers of the past life until the good part of God is manifest inside our lives.

SYNONYMS: Layers, skin, peeling, shell, cocoon, flaking, shedding, loose.

Matt 9:16-17

No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment; for the patch pulls away from the garment, and the tear is made worse. 17 Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

BALLOON

A symbol of our faith after our shell is filled with the breath of God. We begin to lift up and fly above our circumstance.

SYNONYMS: Air balloon, fly, float, feathers, soar, raise up

Ps 55:6

So I said, "Oh, that I had wings like a dove! I would fly away and be at rest.

WHEELS

A time of advancement, moving forward.

SYNONYMS: Carried, boldness, offense, aggressive, advance, lifted.

1 Sam 6:10-14

Then the men did so; they took two milk cows and hitched them to the cart, and shut up their calves at home. 11 And they set the ark of the LORD on the cart, and the chest with the gold rats and the images of their tumors. 12 Then the cows headed straight for the road to Beth Shemesh, and went along the highway, lowing as they went, and did not turn aside to the right hand or the left. And the lords of the Philistines went after them to the border of Beth Shemesh. 13 Now the people of Beth Shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley; and they lifted their eyes and saw the ark, and rejoiced to see it.

ELEPHANT

Elephants can represent intercessors who carry the burdens of the Lord. They are smart and teachable, and serve to carry great weight in the kingdom.

SYNONYMS: See oxen, donkey.

Matt 21:5

'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey .'"

LUMBER YARD

Symbolic of building, rebuilding or restoring God's temple which is the spiritual house we live in.

SYNONYMS: Wood, timber, lumber, 2x4s, plywood, planks, chipboard, forest.

Isa 61:3-4

That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified." And they shall rebuild the old ruins, They shall raise up the former desolations, And they shall repair the ruined cities, The desolations of many generations.

MAGGOTS

The enemy is called Beelzebub, the lord of the flies. Flies are lying spirits and their larva are maggots that eat rotting flesh. Hell is full of the torment of writhing maggots and worms that never die.

We do not want to give food for these worms by living carnal lives which in the end is death.

SYNONYMS: worms, maggots, larva, snakes, caterpillar, centipede.

Matt 12:24

Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, "This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons."

All flesh shall come to worship before Me," says the LORD. 24 "And they shall go forth and look Upon the corpses of the men Who have transgressed against Me. For their worm does not die, And their fire is not quenched. They shall be an abhorrence to all flesh."

SCREW

A parable of fastening and securing one into a stable place in God.

SYNONYMS: Bolt, fasten. See Nail

Isa 22:22-23

The key of the house of David I will lay on his shoulder; So he shall open, and no one shall shut; And he shall shut, and no one shall open. 23 I will fasten him as a peg in a secure place, And he will become a glorious throne to his father's house.

FREEZER

To receive the Word of the Lord and it be preserved during a cold season of life, to be swallowed and received at another time when the environment is warmer and more receptive.

SYNONYMS: ice, cold, deep freeze, frozen, snow, chill, cool.

Prov 25:13

Like the cold of snow in time of harvest Is a faithful messenger to those who send him, For he refreshes the soul of his masters.

SHIP

This is a word pun for leadership that carries people to a destination in God. It is symbolic of a ministry to that nations. The ocean represents nations.

SYNONYMS: Ship, boat, ferry, vessel, craft, liner, transport.

Acts 27:23-25

For there stood by me this night an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve, 24 saying, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must be brought before Caesar; and indeed God has granted you all those who sail with you.'

BANNERS

A parable of being His signs and wonders to the nations on behalf of Jesus Christ.

SYNONYMS: Flag, banner, flagpole, sign, standard, neon light, advertisement, poster, streamer.

Isa 11:10

And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

KJV

OT:5251

OT:5251 nec (nace); from OT:5264; a flag; also a sail; by implication, a flagstaff; generally a signal; figuratively, a token:

KJV - banner, pole, sail, (en-) sign, standard.

MEATBALL

Any kind of meat represents the Word of the Lord that takes some chewing and discernment as to whether they are from Him or not.

SYNONYMS: Beef, meat, wild game

Heb 5:13-14

For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

ZIPPER

A parable of closing the gap, or standing in the breach and making intercession until the hole is closed.

SYNONYMS: Scotch tape, masking tape, glue, bridge, sewing, plastered wall, repair fence, fasten, secure.

Ezek 22:30

So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one.

ICE SKATING

Moving to the rhythm and heart of the Holy Spirit when in difficult and cold circumstances. Overcoming faith against odds.

SYNONYMS: Snow skiing, toboggan, sled, sledge, sleigh.

2 Cor 11:27

In weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness...

FALLEN TREE

A parable of the Lord cutting down a person's fruit, life, ministry, or fellowship.

SYNONYMS: Ban, isolate, fall, captivity, jail, prison, hidden ones

Matt 3:10-11

And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

1 Cor 5:3-5

For I indeed, as absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged (as though I were present) him who has so done this deed. 4 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, 5 deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

Dan 11:32-35

Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. 33 And those of the people who understand shall instruct many; yet for many days they shall fall by sword and flame, by captivity and plundering. 34 Now when they fall, they shall be aided with a little help; but many shall join with them by intrigue. 35 And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.

LOG JAM

This is usually the result of flood waters carrying logs downstream and they getting caught in some kind of a pile up. It represents an obstruction that needs to be removed or release so the clean water can freely flow once again after a demonic flood of engulfing circumstances.

SYNONYMS: debris, rubble, garbage, waste, wreckage.

Ezra 9:9-10

For we were slaves. Yet our God did not forsake us in our bondage; but He extended mercy to us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to revive us, to repair the house of our God, to rebuild its ruins, and to give us a wall in Judah and Jerusalem.

LICENSE PLATE

A license plate is a symbolic parable of being authorized or validated in one's relationship or calling with the Lord.

Often someone's license plate number can be a word from the Lord, using the Strong's number dictionary and also acronyms for the letters.

Isa 44:26

Who confirms the word of His servant, And performs the counsel of His messengers.

SYNONYMS: Driver's license, marriage certificate, passport, certificate, pass, permit, card, ticket.

BRIEF CASE

To carry, store, or move important decrees or proclamations of the Lord.

SYNONYMS: See scroll.

Ps 148:6

He also established them forever and ever; He made a decree which shall not pass away.

PROPELLER

To be motivated by God's zeal, passion, power to advance forward for His kingdom purposes.

SYNONYMS: Thrust, drive, impel, force

Zech 8:1-3

Again the word of the LORD of hosts came, saying, 2 "Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'I am zealous for Zion with great zeal ; With great fervor I am zealous for her.' 3 "Thus says the LORD:

MARCHING BAND

The symbol of God's people marching forward as a united army, one in the Lord, one in purpose, one in pace, one in connection, order and placement.

SYNONYMS: Army, military, soldiers.

Joel 2:7-8

They run like mighty men, They climb the wall like men of war; Every one marches in formation, And they do not break ranks. 8 They do not push one another; Every one marches in his own column. Though they lunge between the weapons, They are not cut down.

PIANO

In my own personal rhema, playing the piano, organ or electric keyboards have represented intercession responding to His heavenly music. It came from a vision I had of hearing 5 keyboardists play the Battle Hymn of Republic in heaven and it was resounding on earth. The Lord told me it was intercession.

SYNONYMS: Bells, xylophone, piano, organ, electric keyboards or any musical instrument.

Ex 28:33-35

And upon its hem you shall make pomegranates of blue, purple, and scarlet, all around its hem, and bells of gold between them all around: 34 a golden bell and a pomegranate, a golden bell and a pomegranate, upon the hem of the robe all around. 35 And it shall be upon Aaron when he ministers, and its sound will be heard when he goes

into the holy place before the LORD and when he comes out, that he may not die.

COAL

A symbol of stoking a fire so that the fire grows hotter. The fire can represent purification, testing, the jealousy of God, gold and silver.

SYNONYMS: Fuel, stoke, stir up, make stronger, Briquette, furnace

Isa 48:10

Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction.

JUNGLE GYM PLAYGROUND

A swing set represents children who are not yet solidified in their relationships with the Lord. They waver back and forth (swing) and they turn upside down as in sifted (monkey bars) and they climb up and then fall down (slide).

A Jungle Gym is the same, except with the addition of a jungle of circumstances where one can not see the forest through the trees.

SYNONYMS: Sway, roll, rock, dangle, hang, suspended, swerve, veer, fall, sift.

James 1:6-8

But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering . For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and

tossed. 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. 8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways. KJV

GAVEL

A symbol of a final decision, verdict, sentence, rule, reign.

SYNONYMS: Pronounce, rule, decide.

John 8:15-17

15 You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. 16 And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me.

1 Peter 4:5-6

5 They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

TAPPING FOOT

To keep in pace or synch with the heart beat of the Lord. What He says, feels, thinks, purposes.

SYNONYMS: knock, beat, strike, pat, drum, pat.

Matt 7:7-9

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

IRON

To apply pressure and heat to release the wrinkles out of clothing. One method God uses to get the wrinkles out of our character and raise us up into the image of Jesus Christ.

SYNONYMS: Flatten, level.

Eph 5:26-27

That He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

RAISIN

The fruit of the vine, dried out and in need of refreshing. He promises to reconstitute us with His rain.

SYNONYMS: Prune, dried fruit

Acts 3:19-21

Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, 20 and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, 21 whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.

AMPHITHEATER

To be surrounded, supported or backed by the Word of God, intercession, and Presence.

SYNONYMS: arena, dome.

Ps 139:5 AMP

You have beset me and shut me in — behind and before, and You have laid Your hand upon me.

PENNY

This is a symbol of one "Sent". (one cent)

SYNONYMS: drive, propel, launch.

Luke 4:43-44

He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent ."

ORANGE JUICE

Bob Jones says that oranges represent friendship with the Lord, to kiss the Son. (Sunkist oranges) In my rhema it means the prophetic. Also in my rhema it has meant to turn the bitter things into sweet gifts. (lemons into orange juice instead of lemonade!)

SYNONYMS: Citrus fruit.

Song 1:2

Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth — For your love is better than wine.

ROOSTER

A wakeup call to no longer spiritually slumber as those in the world slumber. Wake up and understand the spiritual world around you and how it relates to your personal life.

Rom 13:11-13

And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. 12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

BROWN RAIN COAT

Brown is the prophetic symbol of a humble servant or servanthood. A rain coat represents a mantle to wear in God's Presence or rain.

SYNONYMS: Waiter, helper, attendant.

Luke 12:42-45

And the Lord said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season? 43 Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. 44 Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has.

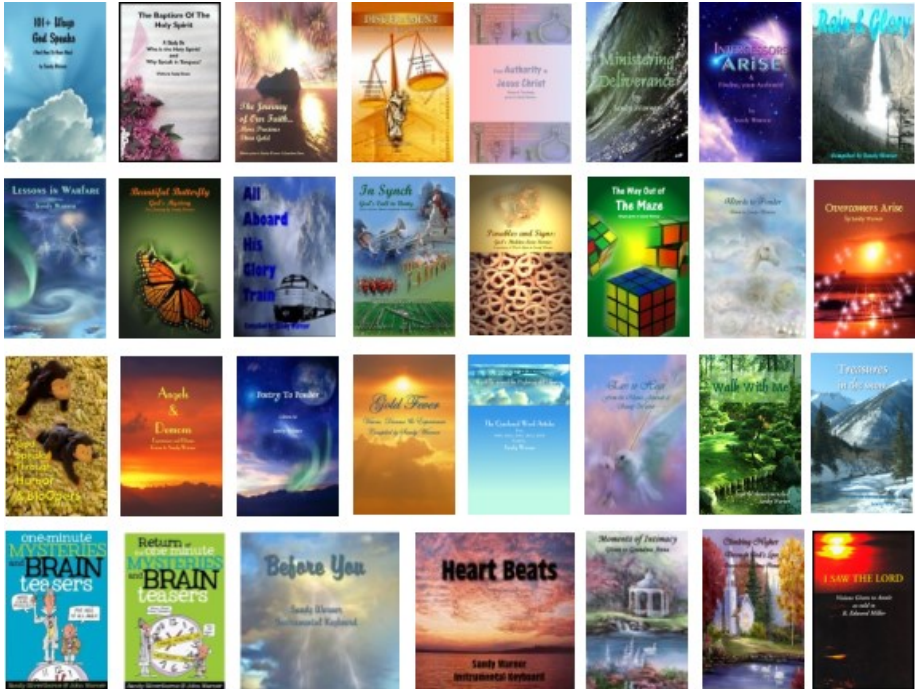
